We continue to celebrate the completion of Joseph's dissertation. It has generated a lot of excitement both among Christians and Muslims. At least a few hundred people have requested a digital copy to read. Our friend, the Grand Imam of Al-Azhar sent his congratulations and is arranging for it to be translated into Arabic so that he can read it. As Joseph has shared it in its current form with colleagues and Muslim religious leaders around the world, he has received much encouraging feedback. Here are some highlights from their remarks:

Lisa recently found out she has breast cancer. She has had surgery and it was confirmed that there is no lymph involvement. Her final treatment will be radiation. Pray for her as she begins treatment, for strength and minimal side effects.

Land was purchased for Lisa and Brad to begin building a home. Pray for wisdom and the resources to complete the project.

#### STACY DAVIS and Family (Africa Inland Mission)

# <u>DAVID and HEIDI (Wycliffe Bible Translators, Peru working from Texas)</u> Praise

1. Despite the pandemic (or because of it), God is at work and the East Apurimac Quechua translated Scriptures are being used to bring people to Christ and strengthen believers. A leader from one community said: "During this pandemic and quarantine time, many people have been seeking God. We could not open the church because the authorities did not allow us to do so, but even so, we have been meeting quietly in small numbers, because many came to my house and



to the homes of other leaders so that we could talk to them about the Bible. Of several who have been seeking God, eleven people were baptized, affirming their faith in the Lord. Before the pandemic, we who congregated in the church were about 50; now we estimate that when the services reopen, we will be about 100."

Yesenia, part of the audiovisual ministry team, has been able to sell 1,714 Quechua New Testaments during this quarter! She has also delivered and monitored 504 'Messengers' and

201 'Proclaimers' (digital devices) with the Quechua audio New Testament. She has also distributed more than 2,500 brochures and books.

2. We and the AIDIA translation team in Abancay, Peru have remained healthy and have made good progress on the checking of the translated East Apurimac Quechua Bible. Most of the steps have been completed for the Old Testament, and we are now working through the New Testament.

#### Prayer

- 1. For strength and wisdom for us and the translators and good progress as we continue checking and revising the Scriptures, including many steps like key terms, parallel passages, cross-references, spelling checks, etc.
- 2. May the translated Quechua Scriptures continue to be used to bring people to Christ, plant new churches, and strengthen believers.
- 3. Protection and effective ministry for our children and their families serving around the world (Ecuador, Texas, Southeast Asia, and the Middle East.)

#### BREATH OF HEAVEN CHILDREN'S VILLAGE (Zambia, Africa)

Our mission is to provide a healing community where the children feel loved, secure, and where special care is given to their emotional, physical, educational, and spiritual development. We believe this is best accomplished in individual family homes of 12 children with a house mother and an auntie offering supervision and discipleship. In addition, these individual family units are part of a larger village community that acts as an extended family.



Our school, church, and medical clinic are an important part of each child's development and enable them to maintain contact with the surrounding community.

Our current need is financial to build the high school, medical clinic, and vocational school. The coronavirus and shutdown prevented us from having our two major fundraising events, the golf tournament, and annual dinner. Both events usually average around \$35,000 in donations. We had a virtual fundraiser in October but there was very little response. \$15,000 came in but \$10,000 came from one donor. it helped to pay for a deficit we had. But we were hoping to raise enough money for equipment for our new science lab that we just built and money for a classroom block and bathrooms. Pray with us as we continue to look to the Lord for His provision.

#### RON and RACHEL (Persian Speaking World via California)

Local - Rachel

Pray for divine appointments each week while she goes shopping. Praise from March 11th to October 21st Rachel has had:

- 232 Spiritual Conversations in an attempt to share the gospel.
- 200 people have received the JESUS DVD plus a tract or the JESUS Film Gift card if they didn't have a DVD player.



- Seven people have received Christ as their Savior from the countries of India, Poland, Mexico, China, Africa, and the U.S.! Praise God!!!
- We trust God that MANY MORE people, out of the 200 who received a JESUS DVD, will accept Christ after watching the movie!

Pray for year-end projects in evangelism, discipleship, church planting, and leadership development in the Persian Speaking World.

 Praise - Ron had his first international trip in October since COVID started. He met with Persian Refugee leaders and Turkish pastors to discuss the persecution response, the need for Farsi Bibles, and the needs of Front Line Workers.
